The mobility in Poland

The visit at our school was focused on team teaching method. Team teaching involves a group of instructors working purposefully, regularly, and cooperatively to help a group of students of any age learn. Teachers together set goals for a course, design a syllabus, prepare individual lesson plans, teach students, and evaluate the results.

For the first time, our students hosted guests from Martinique, Sicily, Turkey and Romania.

Our focus is on excluded students. It is important that in each lesson there was a supportive teacher. This teachers help students with disabilities. We could see good examples of good practices and new methods as far daily activities were concerned.



In the afternoon, there was a big Erasmus+ Quiz about partners' countries and their culture. Students in mixed groups answers the questions. To be fair, all of them came up trumps. We are all the champions in our project.

While the teachers were working, our students and their guests had a great time at school and also after school.



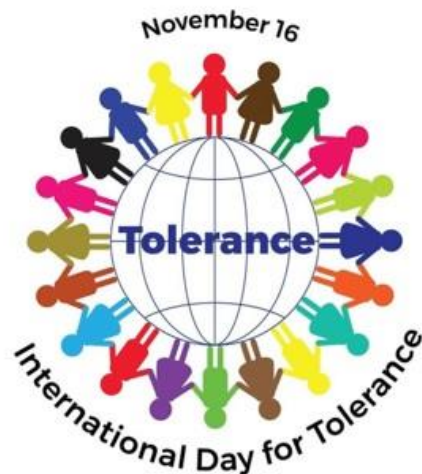
Saturday, 12th MOctober

Sunday, 9th February

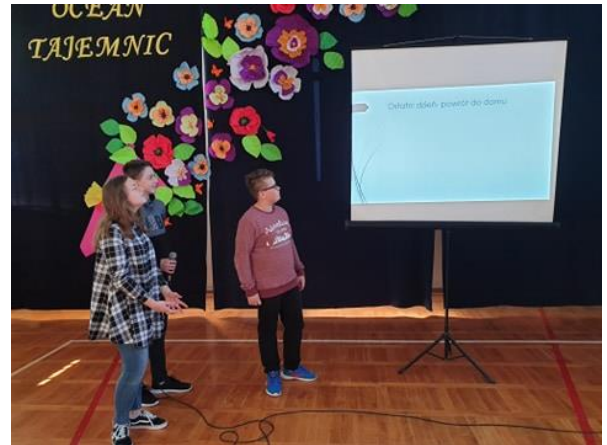
Time to say good bye and leave this small paradise - we went home.

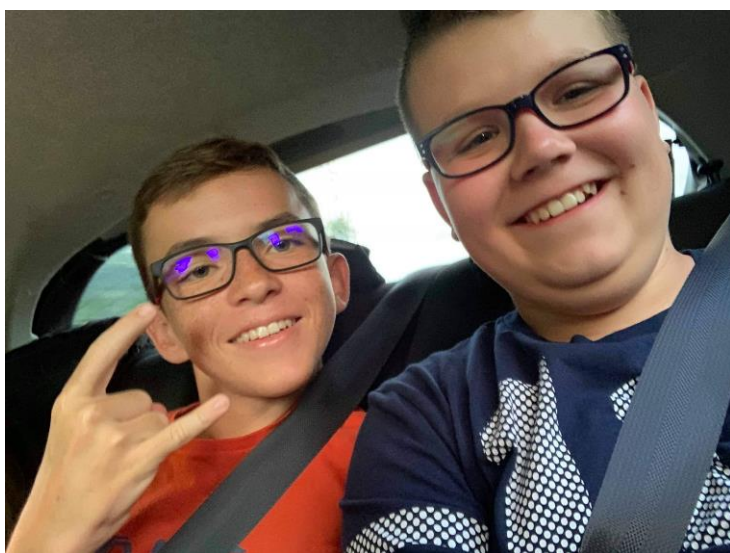
Kamil
